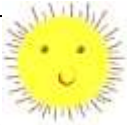

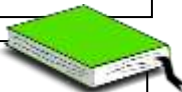
## Maths

- Explore number patterns using coloured pencils
- Cut the 100 square up to make a jigsaw. As your child puts the 100 square back together it'll be interesting to note the strategies and language they use. Feel free to make a note of these.
