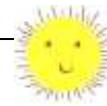
Bikes and scooters

We've loved exploring the bear hunt story and going on adventures in the outdoors. We drew story maps to remind us of the family's journey. You might like to revisit this at home.

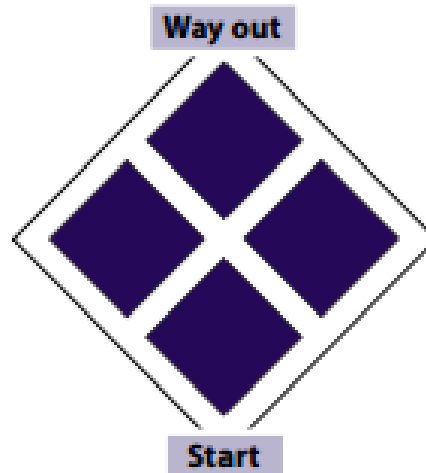


Fun Run
