



This week the children have been learning about plants and what they need to survive – sunlight, nutrients and water. We have been putting on our scientist hats and making some predictions about what would happen to a plant without either sunlight, water or nutrients. next week we will be testing our predictions but feel free to try it at home!

This week we have been recapping the phoneme /th/. It's a digraph – where we have two letters but we squish them together to make one sound, this was a really tricky sound for most of the children so I've asked them to have a practice at home too. It's a long stretchy sound in words like think, thank, thud, Thea and thumb.



The children have two letters to form this week: start at the top of the tower, go down the tower, down the steps and flick, then chop off the top. Start at the horses head, go down to his hooves and up and over his back and flick out his tail.

We have also introduced them to the sound /z/. Zig zag zig down the zip.



This week in Numeracy we have been looking at money – our role play area has become a farmers market and the children have loved the opportunity to handle real money, we have started off with the one pence piece, counting out the amount of pennies required to buy an item of fruit or veg. Why not let your child have a look at some coins at home; look for any numbers or writing and talk about the different sizes and colours of the coins.

This children did brilliantly with The Three Billy Goats Gruff story, so this week they have started to learn the story of Jasper and the Beanstalk, we have been adding actions to the words to help us remember it and making our voices sound exciting- no robot voices allowed! It starts with 'On Monday Jasper found a bean' can your child tell you the rest of the story?

The children are amazed at how quickly the potatoes are growing, they are even taller than some of our Nursery children!
