



This week the children will be making ham and jam sandwiches and perhaps the trickiest challenge we've ever had- they will be buttering their own bread!

Outdoors the children have really enjoyed playing with all of the tools, logs and stones, we have lots of budding little builders – complete with hard hats, safety goggles and high visibility vests!!



This week in our tricky challenge area the children have been trying to open the locks by finding the right key and they have been building stacking towers using velcro rollers., securing them together with hair clips. The most popular challenge has been the hammer and pins, the children have been learning about using the tools safely, it's a great activity that requires a lot of focus and gives those fine motor skills a great workout!

This week we looked at the letter /a/ and learned about the sound that it makes. It's a short bouncy sound. We tried to think of words that start with an /a/ sound – apple, Alexander, alligator, astronaut, ant and antelope. Then we had a look at how to form the letter:



All around the apple, up the leaf, down the leaf and flick.

This week we have been learning about the number 3 and how to form it:



Around the tree and around the tree, that's the way to make a 3. Please find attached number sheets to try at home with your child.
