This week we have been learning about Pancake Day and making cards for Valentines Day. We have been busy rolling play dough pancakes and cooking pancakes in our home corner kitchen.

In Phonics, the children have been learning about the phoneme /c/ and the sound it makes in words at the start of caterpillar, cat, castanets, coat and carrot.



The letter formation rhyme this week: we start at the top of the caterpillars head, then curl around the caterpillar. We have sent some sheets home if you want to practise all of our letter sounds and letter/ number formations. We have also included a name card for you to continue to practise writing your name.

We topped some pancakes with our favourite toppings today – including syrup, sugar bananas, strawberry jam and marshmallows! The best bit was tasting our pancake creations!
