In Phonics, the children have been learning about the phoneme /k/ and the sound it makes in words like kangaroo, king, keyring and kite.



The letter formation rhyme this week: we start at the top of the kangaroo’s head, then down the kangaroo’s body, up along his tail and then down his leg.

Today we made fresh fruit smoothies. The children chopped their chosen fruit themselves before blending with milk and yogurt.
