

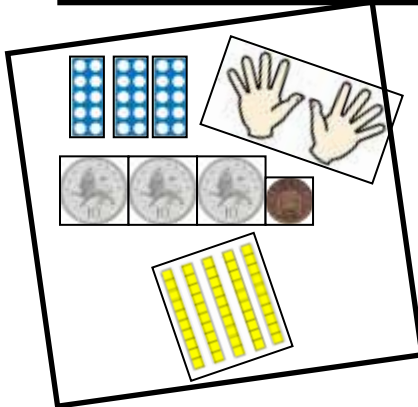
Reception Newsletter 22.4.16



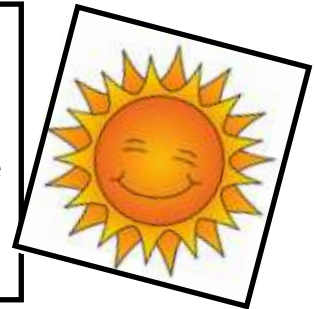
This week we listened to the story of The Rainbow Fish and thought carefully about our favourite part which led to some lovely writing and gorgeous art work.
