

Reception Newsletter 13.5.16

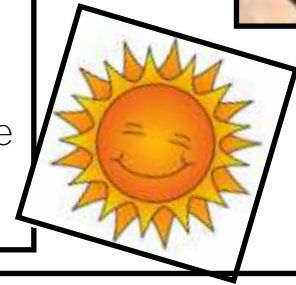
