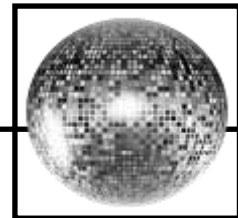
We would like to wish you a very happy half term holiday and we look forward to seeing the children again all refreshed and ready for the next part of the Summer term.
